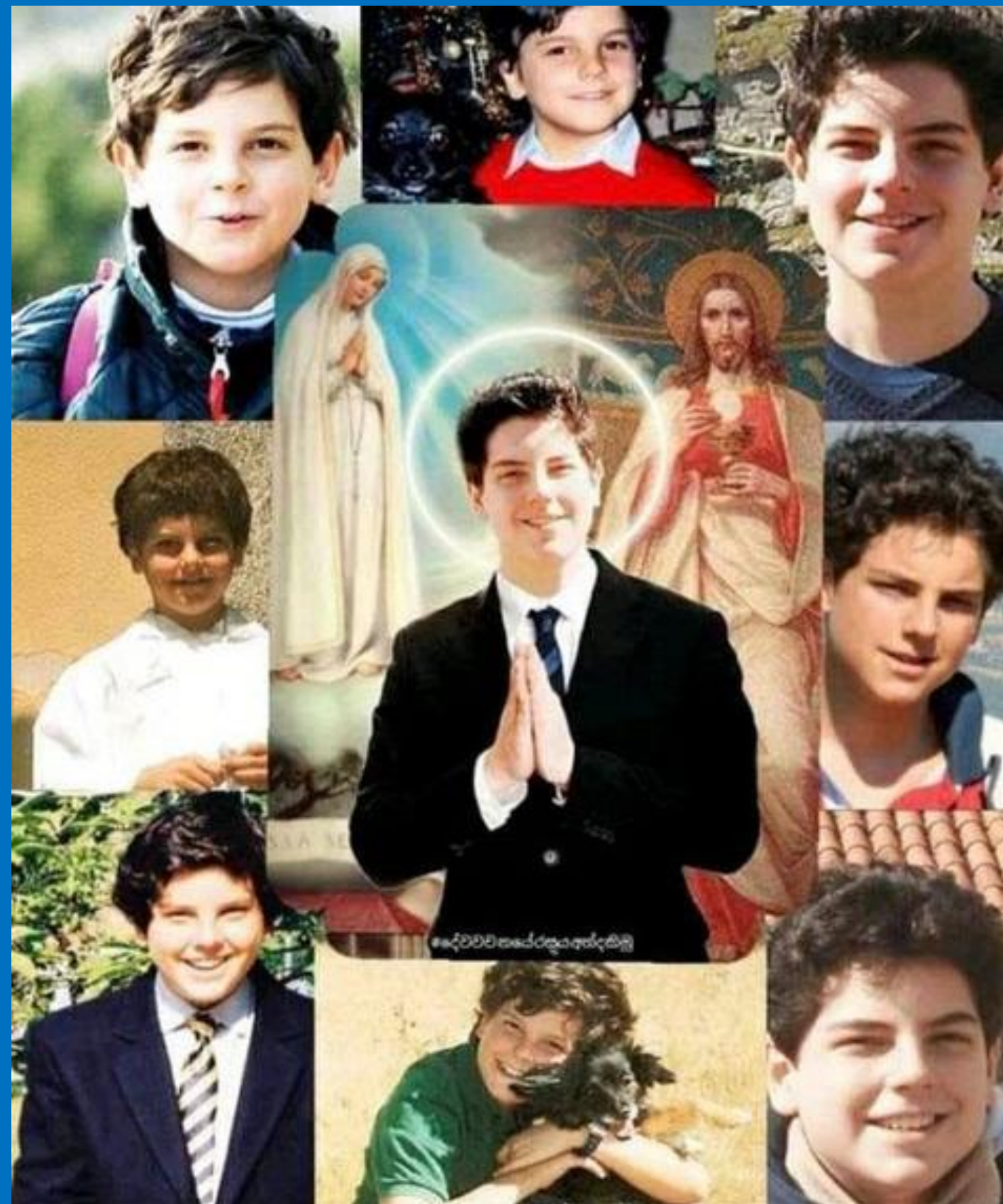
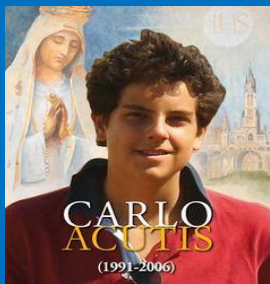

“I like to speak with Jesus about all I am living and feeling.”

Bl. Carlo Acutis (1991–2006) was an Italian teenager known for his deep devotion to the Eucharist and his use of technology to spread the faith. Despite his young age, he created a website documenting Eucharistic miracles worldwide, aiming to help people grow in their belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

He was an active young boy who loved football and video games. He often wanted to go to the church to chat with Jesus and Mary. He asked his parents to bring him to church and he slowly led them back to the faith. He had great kindness in him and had a special love of the poor. With his pocket money he often bought sleeping bags, hot drinks and food for the homeless.

Carlo was diagnosed with leukaemia at age 15 and died within a week. He was beatified in 2020 and will be canonised on Sunday April 27th 2025.

He is a model of holiness for young people in the digital age.

His sayings about the Eucharist were:

- + **“The Eucharist is my highway to heaven.”**
- + **“The more we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of Heaven.”**
- + **“If we go out in the sun, we get a suntan, but when we get on front of the Eucharist, we become saints.”**

Of Life and Love he said:

- + **“You can too be a saint. But you need to want it with your whole heart.”**
- + **“Why do people worry so much about the beauty of their own body and not the beauty of their soul.”**
- + **“Everything passes away. What alone makes us truly beautiful in God's eyes is the way that we loved Him and our brothers.”**
- + **“Everyone is born as an original, but many people end up dying as photocopies.”**

Carlo loved Our Lady and exclaimed:

- + **“Our Lady is the only woman in my life.”**
